Art Camp Aug 1-5

Morning Session 10am-12pm

Look! Learn! Listen!

Ages 5-11 (or with instructor's approval)

"See" and "hear" the world in new ways with Lynn Thomas! Play a bowed string instrument blindfold. Draw an upside down bird. Feel the vibration of a bowed note. Paint what you hear in music. Receive clues to a surprise guest artist or musician each day. Students will receive a violin, viola, or cello to play for the week. (Lab fee \$10)

Bookbinding and Printmaking

Ages 5+

Join Barbara Temple-Ayres for a fun week making a hard-bound book covered with paper you decorate! We will use exciting off-press printmaking techniques such as rubber stamps, monoprints, bubbles, chalk & marbling. (Lab fee \$5)

Illuminated Manuscripts

Ages 9+

Explore the fascinating relationship between text and images. Using drawing, collage and block printing with antique wooden type, students will turn words into works of art with instructor Sarah (Skye) Archer. Bring your own writing, or chose from the teacher's library of stories and poems. This

Beginning Drawing

Ages 8-14

We will learn about basic drawing techniques and how to create textures this week with instructor Angelle Soans. Draw from life or your imagination! Experiment with pencil, charcoal, and marker in your own sketchbook, which students will take home at the end of the week. (Lab Fee \$10)

Clay Playshop

Ages 5-10

Come and get your hands dirty! This playshop with instructor Antoniette Naranjo-Rivera will teach building techniques and explore surface decoration possibilities. Each student will glaze and fire his/her very own piece! (\$15 lab fee)

Intro to Stage Lighting

Ages 7-18

Join instructor Annie Naranjo-Rivera for a rare glimpse into the secret world behind the scenes. We will be learning about the unseen wonders of light design for the stage. Discover how to make our own lighting plot, hang and focus lights and to set the mood for a spectacular show!

Get creative with local poet Travis Champ. We will delve into the wonderful world of poetry this week. Maybe you are a poet and didn't even know it! Create your own booklet of poems to take home at the end of the week. (Lab fee \$5)
